Study Hall: Starting Monday, January 3, we'll be offering an after school study hall on Mondays and Wednesdays from after school until 3:20. This program is to provide students an environment that supports work completion. It is not a tutoring program. Semester Reminder: Most students will change encores to be provided new experiences. Year-long courses are band, choir, and PE for those who selected PE prior to the start of the school year. All others will be assigned at random to provide students a variety of experiences at this level. Some students will be offered a success strategies course determined by the December iReady data.

In addition to new encores, data from the December iReady test will also support placement for advanced math, which starts second semester. August and December iReady results, 2021 M-STEP data, and first semester grades will be used to determine which students are eligible for advanced math. Transitioning from all sections of math being sixth grade math, to two sections of advanced math will result in roughly 25% of our students having a different math teacher for the second semester. Updates will be provided by Wednesday, January 12.
